As a sport, Boccia was originally predominantly played by athletes with cerebral palsy, but has now expanded to include athletes with other disabilities that affect motor skills. All athletes are required to be seated when releasing the ball, and most play from a wheelchair. Athletes can throw, kick or even use a ramp (and a ramp assistant that you get to boss around) to get the ball where you want it to go.

Boccia is widely played as an educational and recreational game, particularly in schools. At Paralympic level, Boccia is one of only two sports which do not have an Olympic counterpart with Goalball being the other.












Getting to Know, our fellow Rotarian... Jeremy Bentvelzen

Jeremy was born at the Nepean Hospital, his mum was Austrian, and his dad was Dutch. His father came to Australia when he was eight and his mum came when she was two. His grandfather, Fred Holzmann had a "Total Service station" and Blue Mountains Mazda at Medlow Bath, next to the Hydro Majestic Hotel. (a very good customer of Scott's Spare Parts)

Jeremy, a self-confessed "nerd", he went to Nepean High School and excelled in Chemistry and Science mainly because they were his two favorite teachers. He was a "naughty nerd" at times and would blow things up using "touch crystals" which was more explosive than nitro-glycerine but in smaller quantities.

When he was in Year 9, he got a loan from his mum to buy an IBM 486 computer. By helping others with their computer problems, he was able to pay back his mum, including interest at 17%. Whilst in years 11 and 12 he got a job working in a computer shop where he learnt to write software.

On finishing school, he had the option of doing science at university. He didn't want to become a schoolteacher, so he decided to go the T.A.F.E. at Mt. Druitt and did casual work in an Optical shop. Two weeks before he graduated with his diploma from T.A.F.E. he got a call for an interview with IDS, an Optical company and started working for them the next day. He stayed there for 9 years and 11 months.

In 2005, Jeremy started a business in his garage with a work collegue called "Auto Reminder". It was a call centre for automotive dealerships. If you bought a car, they would follow up that you were happy with the sales staff and contact customers when

service was due. The aim was to keep customers coming back. The business diversified covering many other industries. At one stage he was the call centre for over 20 dealerships, however with the consolidation of dealership owners, they started to do the calls in house.

Jeremy started another business called "Amity", it provides a complete service in business computer systems. Developing and hosting websites, providing training for his clients, domain names, maintaining cutting edge technology behind the website integration with social media Facebook, Instagram, Linkedin, Google my business, Google Ads, Mailchimp plus many other technologies. Most people can set up their own website these days, however the main issue is for the search engine to find your website and to convince the person that you are the right one. He has in excess of 200 clients and looks after over 400 domains. He employs eight people over his two businesses.

Jeremy is married to Cassandra and they have 14 year old twins. Isaac goes to Nepean High School and Abby goes to St. Columbus at Springwood.

Jeremy is very active in the community and apart from Penrith Rotary is a member of Nepean Business Network. Penrith Chamber of Commerce, Penrith CBD Corporation, his charity work includes being a member of Pink-Up Penrith and Vice President of Penrith Community Kitchen. He is also involved in politics having run campaigns and handing out how to vote leaflets.
