#### CELEBRATING ONE OF OUR MANY PENRITH ROTARY PROJECTS

Recently Past President Barry Cook and I visited the Royal Institute Deaf and Blind Children (Nepean) facility at Glenmore Park.

25 years ago, during Trevor Hall's term as President, our Club took on a major project to establish the landscaping of the land around the Early Childhood Centre at Glenmore Park.



Proceeds from the 1992 Sydney Harbour
Tunnel walk were used to build the centre.
Penrith Pres. **Trevor Hall** said that the project
of landscaping meant a considerable saving
to the institute. The organizing committee
included landscape gardener **Peter Mead**,
retired fire officer **Charles Oxenham**, RAAF
Base Kingswood landscape gardener **John Graham** and **Keith Willoughby**, a plant retailer. Working in weather conditions ranging
from a heat wave to a downpour, the Rotarians in five weekends contoured the site, removed rubbish, paved and built a wall,
placed 5,000 square metres of turf, planted
781 shrubs and constructed a watering sys-




tem. Roy Babbage, of the **Rotary Club of Lower Blue Mountains,** operated his bob-cat free of charge at the site. Members of the **Rotary Club of Nepean** and 20 weekend detainees from the nearby Emu Plains Periodic Deten-

tion Centre also worked on the project.



Donating goods and services were Amgrow, All Class Turf Supplies, Alpine Nursery, Neil Lickerman, Nolan Quarries, GKN Rentals and Mike's Hire.

The Institute acknowledged the Club's work with a special dinner for members and their wives at which Pres. Trevor and P.P. Peter Mead were presented with Life Memberships. The value of the work carried out meant a saving of at least \$65,000 to the Institute.



The **Royal Institute for Deaf and Blind Children** provides a range of educational services for students with vision and/or hearing impairment, including specialist schools for signing Deaf students, oral deaf students, and students with sensory and intellectual disabilities. They offer additional services such as therapy and braille text
