The founders share an unstoppable passion for supporting parents to build friendships, share knowledge around what raising a child with a disability really looks like.

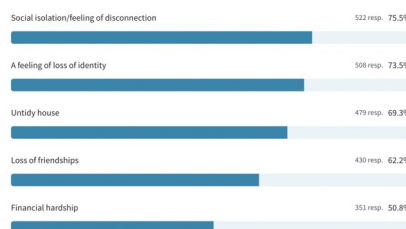

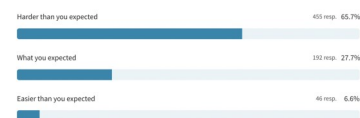
