### HARVEY NORMAN BBQ 30,31 JULY 2022

Thanks to those who attended especially those who were able to tow the two trailers to and from the site.

Peter Mead even with his weakness due to recent ill health was able to deliver the tent and take the garbage for disposal both days – thanks Pete

Ice was collected from MacDonalds by Ross Newell on Saturday and by Jeremy Bentvelzen on the Sunday.

Ice disposed of into the garden beds at around 1.30pm Saturday was still there Sunday morning completely un-melted, we could have kept the ice for Sunday. Saturday night temperatures at around zero prevented it from melting.

Almost a third of our sales are paid through Eftpos - it certainly makes a difference having this facility.

Our BBQs are functioning with a skeleton staff, many working the full day without relief – to be able to hold two BBQs on the one weekend each month may not be feasible in the long run.

Without additional active club members, it will be difficult in the future

BBQs at the Luddenham markets every second week may resume when warmer weather comes – at this stage it is pointless and not a great fund raiser.

Attendance at Harvey Norman and other shops in the complex over the weekend was noticeable quiet – however we sold out all our food on the Saturday and had one bag of sausages and some eggs left over on Sunday.
